

**Mountain Air Ranch Covid-19 Guidelines**  
**Effective 3/28/2021**

Mountain Air Ranch adheres to all restrictions issued by the CDPHE (Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment) and the JCPH (Jefferson County Public Health) and **revisions by those agencies supersede any MAR guidelines.**

- Symptomatic persons prohibited. This means if you have a fever or any other symptom, please do not visit MAR. If you are a resident, please self-quarantine immediately.
  - It is recommended that any person considered “high risk” per CDC guidelines, STAY HOME.
  - Your presence and participation are AT YOUR OWN RISK.
  - Visitors are not allowed on the property.
  - Only Full Members, Friends of MAR Members and guests of members are allowed on the property.
  - Friends of MAR members are required to contact the office and make an appointment to pay for their visit and/or secure a gate code.
  - Members wishing to bring family members and/or guests are required to contact the office and make an appointment to fill out any required paperwork and pay any appropriate fees. The Member shall be responsible for their guest(s) during the entire visit.
  - Social distancing is strongly encouraged in all social situations.
  - Masks are **always** required indoors, as well as outdoors whenever social distancing of 6 feet is not possible. Masks are available for purchase in the office for \$1.00 each.
  - Office – The office is currently open for business Wednesday through Sunday by appointment only. Effective April 1<sup>st</sup> the office is open 7 days a week from 9 am until 5 pm, by appointment only. To make an appointment call Chris 303-435-3044. Between the dates of April 8<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> call Ellen 303-601-3100.
  - Per the health orders, there are capacity restrictions. Please understand and be patient if any area is at capacity and your use of it is restricted.
  - Members are asked to sanitize after using any indoor facility. Disinfectant solutions provided in all common areas.
- Front Gate keypad – if you are not using a fob or card, please use a pen/pencil to push buttons on the keypad.
- Sport Court Usage: Sports equipment cannot be adequately disinfected and therefore any Sports Court (tennis, bocce, horseshoes, and shuffleboard) usage is at your own risk.
