

MAR Golf Cart Policy Effective July 15, 2021

General Policy:

MAR members and visitors may use electric golf carts safely on MAR property. No gas golf carts are allowed.

Condition, Parking and Charging

Golf carts must be kept in running condition, and should not have visible flaws (severely faded paint, large dents, flat tires, etc).

When not in use golf carts, should be parked immediately adjacent to annual campsite or site rented in the RV Travel meadow. Since the cost of electricity to charge golf carts is the responsibility of the owner, charging should be accomplished only with electricity provided with the annual or rented site. Charging at any other electrical box (except in emergency situations where batteries are dead and cart cannot be moved), must be approved by the Manager.

Use of Member/Visitor Golf Carts

Drivers of golf carts must be licensed drivers, except that an unlicensed driver 10 years or older may drive a cart if their parent or the golf cart owner is physically present in the cart. The only exception is for use of golf carts during a ranch-sanctioned event where supervision and safety measures are in place (e.g., Golf Cart Rodeo).

To ensure golf cart safety, occupancy is limited to Manufacturer's recommended occupancy for safety.

MAR-Owned Golf Carts

MAR-owned golf carts are exclusively reserved for the use of staff, and Committee Members (Membership, Entertainment, Facilities, Publicity) when performing Committee business. Membership Committee has priority access to the MAR-owned six-seater cart for tours.

Any exceptions to the use of MAR-owned golf carts must be approved by the manager. Any damage incurred when using a MAR-owned cart must be immediately reported to the Manager.
