Covid-19 Guidelines Effective July 18, 2020

Per the Colorado State and Jefferson County “Safer at Home and in the Vast, Great Outdoors” orders published by the Jefferson County Public Health Department, including amendments and emergency executive orders, all members, guests and visitors will be required to follow these guidelines.

- Only members, their guests and applicants in process are allowed until “Safer at Home and in the Vast, Great Outdoors” restrictions are lifted. Guest visits are subject to state restrictions and must make an appointment to visit.
- Symptomatic persons prohibited. This means if you have a fever or any other symptom, please do not visit MAR. If you are a resident, please self-quarantine immediately.
- Your presence and participation are AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- It is suggested that all persons considered “high risk” per CDC guidelines, STAY HOME.
- Only full members welcomed with unlimited access, subject to capacity restrictions as outlined below.
- Friends of MAR are welcome but are encouraged to call ahead to the office to ensure access to all areas of MAR due to capacity restrictions.
- Social distancing of six feet is required for all indoor events (including those moved indoors due to weather), and strongly encouraged in all social situations.
- Masks are required inside all buildings (except when dining) and outdoors when social distancing of six feet is not possible. Masks are available for purchase in the office for \$1.00 each.
- Per the health orders, there are capacity restrictions in the pool and pool area, dining room and upper clubhouse. Please understand and be patient if any of these areas are at capacity and your use of them is restricted.
- Front Gate keypad – please use a pen/pencil to push buttons on the keypad and/or use the isopropyl alcohol spray (provided) to clean, before and after use.
- Office – maximum 2 persons at a time, in addition to staff.
- Any gatherings in the upper clubhouse are limited to 50 persons.
- The pool at MAR is open, but all users must sign a waiver and a maximum of 60 persons may be in the pool area at any one time. Pool area is defined as the concrete and wood decking with lounge chairs. Please maintain pool chair location/spacing as set by staff (do not rearrange them).
- Disinfectant solutions provided in all common areas. Please be responsible and use them, before and after your personal use.
- Staff will be disinfecting and cleaning the common areas 4 times a day.
- A max. 2 people may use the hot tub at the same time with social separation and masks required. Maintain distancing while waiting for your turn.
- A max. 2 people may use the sauna at a time with distancing & masks required. Maintain distancing while waiting for your turn.
- Lost Bikini Grill – All are encouraged to order food at the Lost Bikini Grill via the outside door. The dining room has been set up for social distancing; tables and chairs should not be moved. When tables in the dining room are full, all others must wait outside, using social distancing, until a free table becomes available.
 - Friday – dinner, 5pm-7pm, Saturday – lunch, 11am-2pm and dinner, 5pm-7pm
 - Sunday –lunch, 11am – 2pm
- Ice Cream Parlor – one person allowed inside, in addition to staff. Hours:
 - Friday: 5pm – 7pm, Saturday: 12pm – 6pm, Sunday: 12pm – 4pm
- Sport Court Usage: Sports equipment cannot be adequately disinfected and therefore any Sports Court (tennis, bocce, horseshoes and shuffleboard) usage is at your own risk.
